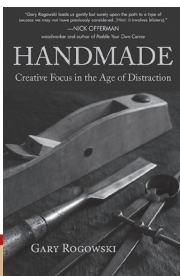

Gary Rogowski

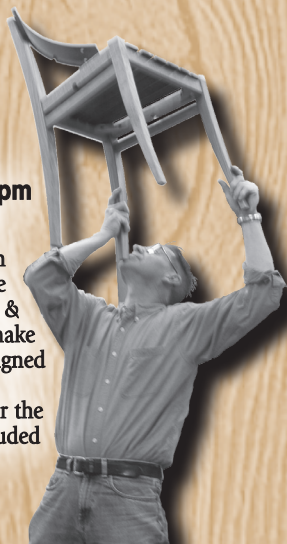

In 1991, he won the Oregon Arts Commission Fellowship in Crafts. In 1997 he founded The Northwest Woodworking Studio, a School for Woodworkers. He now teaches online students from around the world. Gary was a Contributing Editor for FWW Magazine for 14 years. He is the author of "Handmade: Creative Focus in the Age of Distraction" & "The Complete Illustrated Guide to Joinery".

"Handmade" is a narrative nonfiction book on creativity, practice and inspiration in this time of attention disorder. It argues for the value of doing things well, the need to work with our hands and to use our hands to help us to think & engage with the world.

Building a Wooden Block Plane with Gary Rogowski

There is nothing better than building stuff for your shop. And making bench tools that you need & that are built well & that are handsome, all at the same time, is a gift to yourself.

Join us in this 2-day class building a high angle block plane. You can't buy one at this bed angle, this design creates a tool that is unmatched when cutting through highly figured wood, knots, or surprise grain direction changes. First you'll make a white oak blank, then you'll cut it up to make a bed & wedge pin to hold the iron in place. Finally, you will shape & personalize the tool for use.

This is sure to be an inspiring & entertaining class!

It's a treat to be able to make your own hand tools. When you grab for this high angle plane in that special situation & it does the job well, you will gain a special sort of satisfaction.

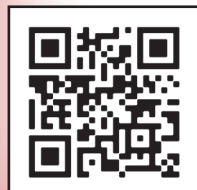
